This is the thirteenth year of the Chairman's Awards. The awards recognise, reward and celebrate the exceptional achievements of staff, whether as an individual or a team within the Trust.

A Guide to Entering Awards

Who can submit an entry?

Entries can be made by any member of staff.

Submitting an entry

Entries are accepted by completing the online entry form. There is no limit to the number of entries you can make; however, a separate entry form must be submitted for each category. The same scheme cannot be entered into more than one category.

What is the deadline to submit an entry?

Completed nominations must be received by Wednesday 18 August 2021.

When will people know if they have been shortlisted?

Judging will take place during September 2021 and all successful and unsuccessful entries will be contacted. The judging panel will draw up a shortlist of entries. The shortlisted entries will then receive a virtual visit from the judges.

Prizes

First prize in each of the categories is a silver perpetual cup and £10,000 to reinvest back into your service. Second prize is £3,000 and third prize is £2,000 both for service reinvestment. Winners in the WOW category will receive £1,000 for service reinvest.

Monetary awards will be available to spend in the financial year 2021/22. You will be required to outline your proposals for spending your award money and forward this to your Director, via and with the support of your line manager. When your proposals for using the awards money have been agreed with your Director, your Director should notify Finance and arrange payments of the invoices.

Awards Night

We hope to be able to invite staff from shortlisted categories to attend an evening gala dinner in the Belfast City Hall on Thursday 25 November 2021; however, a decision may be taken to move to a virtual event to ensure we comply with COVID-19 event guidance.
