To sign up you must:

- Have a BMI greater than 25kg/m2
- Be over the age of 18
- Be an HSC NI staff member
- Consult a GP before starting if you have a medical condition.

No cost is incurred for those with inclusive contracts however both pay-as-you-go and ROI numbers (without an inclusive contract) will be charged.
