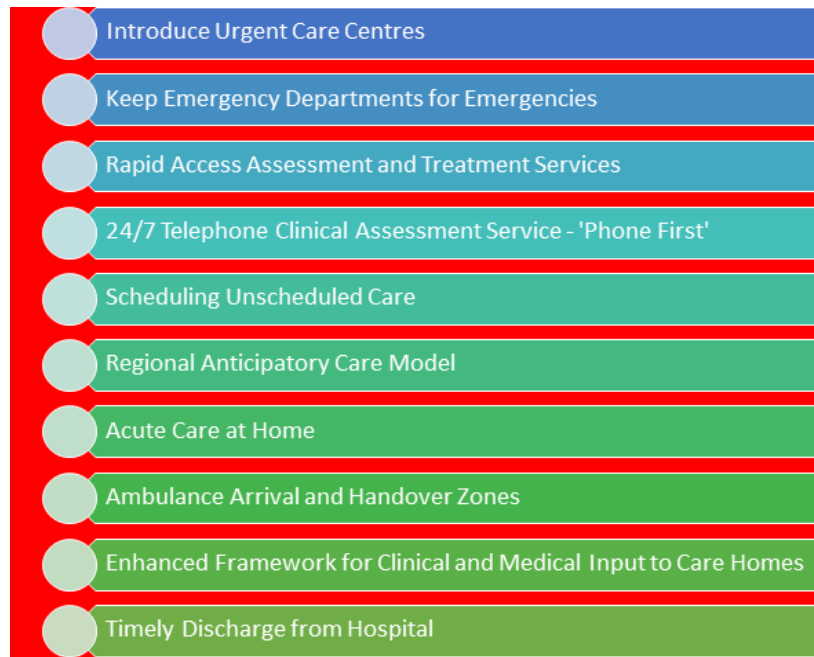


This comprises key actions to ensure that urgent & emergency care services across primary and secondary care can be maintained and improved in an environment that is safe for patients and for staff, both in terms of the pressures we anticipate facing this winter and the systemic issues faced by emergency care generally.

The interim No More Silos Network provides strategic direction and support required to develop the key principles and plans to deliver 10 key actions:



The strategic network is supported by 5 Local Implementation Groups, which comprise leaders across both Primary and Secondary Care. Initially, the focus will be to ensure that plans presented to the Minister have been developed on the basis of local knowledge and have secured engagement with front line colleagues. This makes it all the more important for the Trust and Primary Care to work together to ensure the implementation plan is based on system-wide experience and expertise.
