The Health Minister has made the following announcement in relation to free parking for HSE staff:

"I have asked Trusts to proceed with putting in place arrangements to extend free parking for staff for another four months. I am aware that with the hope of further recovery from the pandemic and associated rebuilding of the HSC, it is anticipated that many more parking spaces will be required for patients and visitors.

This will mean that it will not be possible to provide onsite free car parking for staff to the same levels as in the first two periods, and my officials are working with Trusts and others on a range of potential offsite solutions. Trusts will be keeping staff informed at a local level."

All arrangements to meet the Health Minister's announcement of free parking, will be kept under review to ensure that, as the Trust begins to rebuild services, the impact on patients, visitors and staff is kept to a minimum.
