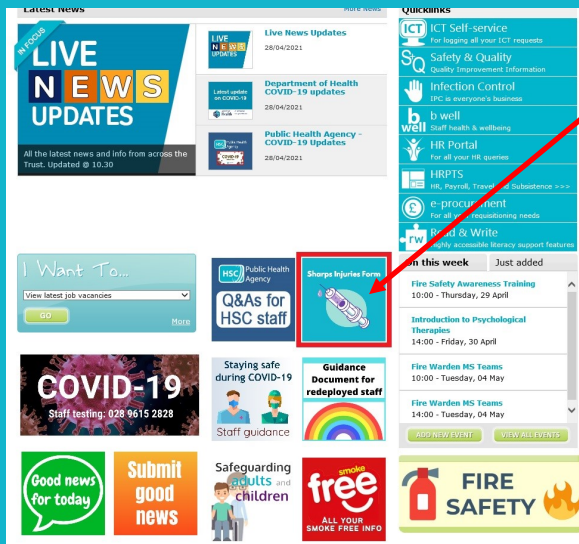

Reporting Sharps Injuries



- Download the Sharps Care Pathway from the Hub icon.
- Note the BOH/number - this will be the patient's identity from now on.
- Get written risk assessment from Nurse/ Doctor/person in charge.
- Send blood from the patient to the virology lab ASAP (test for Hep B, Hep C and HIV).
- Use the Sharps Care Pathway to accompany patient's blood.
- Ring Occupational Health (028 9063 0010) and leave your name DOB, contact number, details of event & your Manager's name, plus the BOH number on the pathway.

High Risk Injuries need seen immediately at Occupational Health.
If 'Out of Hours' go immediately to E.D. with the Pathway.
