On Street Parking

The daughter of a resident in a street near to the Royal Hospitals site, wrote to the Trust regarding hospital staff parking all day in the street which prevented her, her sisters, and Trust Nursing and Domiciliary Care staff being able to park at the house to provide essential care. parking in nearby streets creates an inconvenience for residents and at worst it could cause a serious issue with preventing access for services, deliveries or emergency vehicles. Parking in Restricted Areas

The Trust now has in place parking enforcement measures to ensure the free flow of traffic through sites. It is not acceptable for staff to continue parking on double yellow lines, in patient set down areas or at bus stops during their shift and then become aggrieved when they receive a Parking Charge Notice.
