2. How many pregnant women are currently in ICU in Northern Ireland because of Covid?

There are currently < 5 pregnant women in ICU because of COVID. This only reflects Belfast Health and Social Care Trust.

3. How many pregnant women have been treated as regular inpatients in Northern Ireland, because of Covid? Month by month if possible.

Between 1st March 2020 and 30th April 2021 (the latest timeframe possible due to clinical coding) there have been less than 10 pregnant women admitted to Belfast Health and Social Care Trust as a regular inpatient (i.e. not pregnancy/delivery related) who were Covid positive.
