COVID-19

- 1. Of the patients who were admitted into any Belfast Trust hospital from January 2021 up to the present day, how many had received at least 1 COVID-19 vaccination?**

Belfast Trust is unable to respond, as we do not hold this level of detail regarding individual patients' vaccination status. The vaccination status of individual patients is not documented consistently in patient records and is not recorded on a central system in the Trust. The vaccination status of individuals is recorded onto the Regional Vaccine Management System, to which Belfast Trust do not have full access.

- 2. Of the patients who were admitted into any Belfast Trust hospital from January 2021 up to the present day, how many were hospitalised as a result of suffering from an adverse reaction or event related to their COVID-19 vaccination?**

Belfast Trust is unable to respond, as we do not hold this level of detail regarding individual patients' hospitalised as a result of suffering from an adverse reaction or event related to their COVID-19 vaccination.

- 3. When a patient who is admitted has been vaccinated with the COVID-19 vaccine, and is hospitalised as a direct result of suffering from an adverse reaction or event following their COVID-19 vaccine, does a qualified medical professional use the MHRA Yellow card reporting scheme to log the information?**

Anyone can submit a MHRA Yellow card reporting scheme to log an adverse reaction. The submission of a MHRA Yellow card for individual patients is not documented consistently in patient records and is not recorded on a central system in the Trust. Unfortunately this level of detail would not be available from Yellow card reporting data currently available. We only know the amount of reports per vaccine from Northern Ireland as a region.
