Please release details of discussions at senior management and board level since March 2020 to December 2021 concerning the following:

- 1. Liability in relation to Covid-19 action / inaction including duty to treat**
- 2. What early treatment protocols and advice have been considered to keep people from being admitted to hospital with Covid-19 in the first place;**
- 3. Potential violations of the Hippocratic Oath;**
- 4. Obligations re informed consent (to take Covid-19 vaccinations);**
- 5. Liability arising from forced or coerced vaccinations;**
- 6. The impact of mooted mandates (to have Covid-19 vaccinations) in terms of loss of operational capability including the potential numbers of lay-offs involved;**
- 7. Liability accruing to the Trust for discharging infected seniors from hospital and putting them back in nursing homes where there were resultant outbreaks of Covid-19; and**
- 8. Any discussions or debate re Great Barrington Declaration, Rome Declaration and Nuremberg Code**

Information is not held in respect of Q1 and Q3-8.
