Subject: Brackenburn Clinic

Question 1:

I am looking for information on how many people have died while on your list by suicide or misadventure. –

- The Trust have no ability to capture this data for the Brackenburn Clinic waiting list.

Question 2:

What steps are being taken to reduce the waiting list

- For the Brackenburn Clinic, the Trust have appointed a locum Consultant Psychiatrist 3 days per month to help address the current waiting list. The Trust is also working very closely with the Health and Social Care Board in reviewing current service provision and developing a new proposed service model going forward.

Question 3:

What steps are being taken currently to supply mental health support for people on that waiting list?

- All individuals on the Brackenburn Clinic waiting list have access to mental health support via their General Practitioner, they are also furnished with a list of Community & Voluntary organisations that can offer support.

Question 4:

What access to medication is available

- Access to medication through the Brackenburn Clinic is only available following assessment at the Brackenburn Clinic.

Question 5:

What access is there to specialised psychology and psychiatry is available

- All patients on the Brackenburn Clinic waiting list have access to specialised psychology and psychiatry via a referral from their General Practitioner.
