TODAY YOU WILL RECEIVE AN INJECTION OF AN IODINATED BASED CT CONTRAST AGENT AND YOU MAY ALSO RECEIVE A DRINK OF IODINATED BASED CT CONTRAST AS PART OF YOUR CT SCAN

CONTRAST NAME: **OMNIPAQUE 300**

As per manufacturers guidance we have to inform you that you may experience some of the side effects listed below.

The frequency of these undesirable side effects is rare (>1/10,000 to <1/1000)

Headache, nausea and vomiting, sneezing, wheezing, a runny nose, eye irritation, itching, hives, a skin rash, swelling of the face, mouth, hands, feet or throat, difficulty in breathing or low blood pressure

If you experience any of these side effects, you should contact your GP for advice. If you are an in-patient please inform your nurse or doctor.

If symptoms occur out of hours, contact your local emergency department.
