We have made redactions to these emails as we are not able to provide personal information under the Freedom of Information Act. This information is subject to Section 40(2) of the FOI Act 2000 – Personal information relating to a third party. This is deemed to be personal information about another individual and disclosure would breach one or more of the principles of the Data Protection Act.

We are not able to provide the monitoring forms which are attached to some of the emails. They contain sensitive information and due to low numbers of <5, we consider that individuals could be identified and disclosure of this information would breach the first data protection principle, which relates to the fair and lawful processing of personal data. Therefore, we have concluded that this information is exempt from disclosure under FOI Act Section 40(2) Personal Information relating to a third party.
