The UK Yellow Card Scheme: The MHRA runs the Yellow Card Scheme, which collects and monitors information on suspected safety concerns on medicines and vaccines. This scheme relies on voluntary reporting of suspected safety concerns by Healthcare Professionals or Members of Public.
