## Treatment of Haemophilia A

### Request

I am researching the incidence and treatment of Haemophilia A across different NHS trusts and health boards. I have already consulted the annual report published by the UKHCDO but need current information at the individual organisation-level, which is not present in the annual report. Can I therefore request you to answer the following two questions.

1. How many patients are registered with your Haemophilia Centre for

- Haemophilia A
- Haemophilia A – severe disease
- Haemophilia A – moderate disease
- Haemophilia A – mild disease

Q2. In the last three months, how many patients have been treated by your haemophilia centre for prophylaxis or for bleeding episodes with the following products?

- Factor VIII (any brand)\*
- Emicizumab
- Emicizumab in combination with any Factor VIII

\*please note I am not seeking any commercially sensitive information - simply the total number of patients on any factor VIII product.

### Response

The information requested is exempt under Section 21: Information already reasonably accessible. The information requested is readily available from the National Haemophilia Database (NHD).

We supply treatment in line with the National Framework and report all diagnosis, treatments and regimes on a quarterly basis to the National Haemophilia Database provided by the UKHCDO. Any individual/company can apply to the National Haemophilia Database for this information.
