Infection Control Protocols

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information regarding Belfast Health & Social Care Trust infection control protocol.

1. In 2025, what forms of PPE are used on wards where there are sick and/or medically vulnerable patients?

A range of single-use Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is recommended on the wards, including Filtering Facepiece Protection Level 3 (FFP3) respirators, fluid-resistant surgical masks, visors, aprons, long-sleeved fluid-resistant gowns, and gloves.

2. In 2025, what is the protocol that must be undertaken when a patient becomes sick in hospital with Covid-19?

The Infection Prevention Control Team provides guidance based on the 'Respiratory Illnesses Guidance (including COVID-19)', which is available on the Public Health Agency website.

3. In 2025, what models of face masks are currently used to prevent spread of viral illness in healthcare environments? (I.e., FFP2, FFP3).

Based on a range of factors, the Infection Prevention Control Team may recommend the use of either single-use fluid-resistant surgical masks or Filtering Facepiece Protection Level 3 (FFP3) respirators to prevent the spread of viral illnesses in healthcare environments.

4. In 2025, are HEPA filters or any types of air filters or tools for air circulation utilised in your healthcare environments to prevent spread of illness?

Yes, High Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) filtered portable air circulation units are located across departments where they have been risk assessed and determined to require this level of filtration.
