Adult ADHD

A copy of any policy guidance and information which clarifies the eligibility/methodology for assessment in respect of ADHD.

For new patients referred by their GP for assessment, the attached enhanced triage guidance is applied

A copy of any system in place which determines as to how individuals on the list may be prioritised.

Prioritisation is currently given to internal trust transfers for individuals transferring from CAMHS and Paediatrics where their treatment regime has been commenced

Bequest for clarification on response:

Does this relate to individuals being prioritised for treatment as opposed to assessment / diagnosis or is it the case that this refers to individuals who have had a treatment regime commenced without a diagnosis? Our questions related to who gets priority to be simply assessed for a diagnosis of ADHD.

Within the existing limited resource priority is given to those who have a diagnosis and have commenced on a treatment regime within trust services. As capacity permits individuals awaiting assessment consideration are taken off a waiting list in chronological order.
