Abuse of adults with a learning disability

1- How many allegations of abuse of adults with a learning disability in community settings from 2020- Present day

2597 total Adult Safeguarding referrals from April 2020-March 2025. 1740 allegations of abuse of adults with a learning disability in a community setting from April 2020- March 2025. 1740 community referrals 28 acute general hospital referrals 829 learning disability hospital referrals

2- How many allegations of abuse of adults with a learning disability in an acute setting from 2020-present.

28 allegations of abuse of adults with a learning disability in an acute general setting were reported from April 2020-March 2025.

3- In respect of question one - How many of the allegations were substantiated?

Adult Safeguarding referral outcomes are not a requirement for SPPG Adult Safeguarding Returns, or Department Of Health reporting requirements. This data is not available from Encompass or Paris Digital Communication Information Systems. This would require an extensive manual retrieval of digital and paper records.

To undertake this exercise would necessitate a manual interrogation of data which would involve a significant number of hours. This would exceed the costs limit specified in the FOI act.

We estimate that compliance with this element of the request for information would exceed the appropriate costs limit. Under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information 2000, the limit has been specified as £450 and represents the estimated cost of one or more persons spending 18 hours in determining whether we hold the information, locating, retrieving and extracting this information.

4- In respect of question two - How many of the allegations were substantiated?

Adult Safeguarding referral outcomes are not a requirement for SPPG Adult Safeguarding Returns, or Department Of Health reporting requirements. This data is



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not available from Encompass or Paris Digital Communication Information Systems. This would require an extensiive manual retrieval of digital and paper records.

BHSCT has 1 Adult Safeguarding Champion representing the Trust. BHSCT continue to deliver Level 3 of the NIASP Training frameworking (2016) Nominated Adult Safeguarding Champion/Line Manager, for the reporting period 2024-25 – 466 staff were trained to level 3 within BHSCT.
