## **Congenital Cholesteatoma Cases (Royal Victoria Hospital, 2013–2016)**

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would like to request the following information for the Royal Victoria Hospital, Belfast:

1. The number of patients diagnosed or treated for congenital cholesteatoma for each year from 2013 to 2016, inclusive.

  - Whether treatment was provided as inpatient, day-case, or outpatient.

We cannot identify when a patient is diagnosed with Congenital Cholesteatoma, therefore unable to provide number of new cases diagnosed in any given year  
 We have no identifiable information for outpatients

Congenital Cholesteatoma cases were identified using ICD-10 codes H71.x and H60.4
