## Car Parking Allocation Process

**1. What percentage of staff who come from PCSS background were successful at application for a car parking space?**

Out of a total number of 96 staff who applied and were identified as PCSS applicants ( `Catering` , `Domestic` , Hotel Services` , `PCSS` or `Transport` in role), 21% of these staff were successful prior to the pause

**2. Within the PCSS professional group, what percentage of applicants from carparking services and associated managerial roles related to carparking were successful in obtaining a space?**

\*\* The % of the successful PSS staff were from carparking services/associated managerial roles relates to less than 5 staff.

**3. What percentage of nursing applicants were successful in obtaining a space?**

Out of a total of 1,239 staff who applied and were identified as nursing applicants ( `nurse` or `nursing` in role), 56% of these staff were successful prior to the pause

**4. What percentage of medical staff were successful in obtaining a space?**

Out of a total of 424 staff who applied and were identified as medical applicants ( `consultant` in role), 60% of these staff were successful prior to the pause

**5. What percentage of staff applications stating a role of carer/caring role for dependents or those with a health condition were successful?**

Out of a total of 2,013 staff who applied and selected the caring role criteria, 29% of staff were successful prior to the pause. Health conditions did not form part of the criteria selection so this information is not available. Staff who hold a Blue Badge receive automatic parking outside the permit process. Staff who require temporary parking due to a health condition can be facilitated outside the permit process.

\*\* We are unable to provide an exact figure where numbers are very low. To provide this level of information would reduce numbers to discoverable limits where the patients could be identifiable.

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This is exempt from release under section 40(2) Personal Information relating to a third party, of the FOI Act. Disclosure would constitute a breach of the principles of the Data Protection Act 2018.

**6. What percentage of staff who had come off on call rotas for health reasons had car parking applications declined?**

We would not be able to give a figure as this was not part of the verification information requested. See response to point 5 in relation to blue badge holders and temporary permitted parking due to a health condition
