## **Regional Acquired Brain Injury Unit Inpatient Statistics**

- 1. Can you advise how many inpatient beds it holds and the approximate daily number of outpatients?**

The Regional Acquired Brain Injury Unit has 23 inpatient beds. In terms of non-inpatient activity, there are approximately 5 day attenders each day. In addition, the service runs 3 outpatient clinics per week, with approximately 10 patients attending each clinic.

- 2. Does the length of time being an inpatient vary upon need or is it a set number of weeks etc?**

The length of an inpatient stay varies depending on each patient's diagnosis, rehabilitation needs, and agreed treatment plan as determined by the multidisciplinary team. There is no standard set number of weeks that applies to all patients.

- 3. Are there delays in being discharged?**

Discharge delays can occur. Where this happens, it is usually related to package of care arrangements, including coordination with other Trusts where ongoing support is required following discharge.
