Ovarian Cancer Treatments

Paclitaxel in combination with a platinum-based compound	37
Platinum-based therapy alone (cisplatin or carboplatin)	33

Currently there are no studies open in ovarian cancer in Belfast Trust however we have participated in the prevention study 'Protector: Preventing Ovarian Cancer through early Excision of Tubes and late Ovarian Removal' (currently paused to recruitment for sponsor study amendments and due to re-open soon). There are currently 53 people recruited to this study by Belfast Trust.
