Mr McConaghy provided a high level overview of the staff survey results with an increase in responses and also an increase from 3.80 to 3.84 as the overall engagement score, the highest the engagement score has been. Dr Sloan enquired in relation to triangulation with grievance and complaint information, with the staff survey reports. Mr McConaghy confirmed that Directorate reports will be issuing shortly, while there is also a detailed dashboard review to be considered at the People and Culture committee. It was noted that it was imperative for Directorates to take action on foot of the survey results, in order to improve engagement, particularly where issues of concern were apparent. Mr McConaghy noted that the staff survey results were part of the narrative of staff experience, not the entire experience.
