WATCH FOR SIGNS OF FUEL POVERTY AND COLD HOMES THAT COULD CONTRIBUTE TO AVOIDABLE WINTER DEATHS

Have you noted any of your clients in homes?

- Below 18°C
- Living in one room
- Using inappropriate sources to heat a cold room
- Staying in heated public places
- Using candlelight to save on electric use
- Keeping curtains closed to retain heat

Who are any of the following:

- Older (65 and over)
- Young child (5 and under)
- Frequently homeless
- Living on a low income
- Pregnant
- Recent immigrant and/or asylum seeker

Or may have:

- A cardiovascular, respiratory (particularly COPD) or childhood asthma condition
- Mental Health condition
- A disability
- An addiction issue
- Or who have attended hospital due to a fall
