NEW Belfast Trust Hyperkalaemia Kit for the Management of Hyperkalaemia in Hospitalised Adults

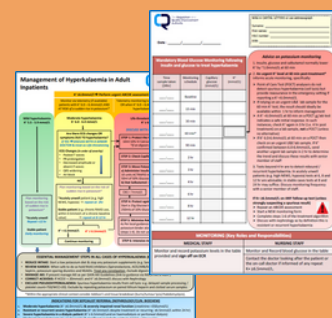


The content of the Belfast Trust Hyperkalaemia kit is changing in response to updated RQIA guidelines for the Treatment of Hyperkalaemia in Hospitalised Adults (March 2021). The major changes are revised recommendations for monitoring of blood glucose before and after the treatment of hyperkalaemia.

Why? The change to guidelines is in recognition of the risk of hypoglycaemia in patients receiving insulin and glucose as part of the treatment for hyperkalaemia. The new hyperkalaemia kit will include a 2-sided insert with the Algorithm for the Management of Hyperkalaemia in Adult Inpatients on one side and the Mandatory Blood Glucose Monitoring chart on the reverse.

Wards who hold hyperkalaemia kits will also need to ensure they stock Glucose 10%.

How? Hyperkalaemia kits will be changed over on Thursday 1st July 2021. The changeover will be facilitated by the pharmacy department on all acute sites. e.g. RVH, RMJH, BCH, MIH and MPH.
