## **Covid-19 Vaccination and any reported links with Increase in Miscarriage / Effects on Women's Reproductive System**

**Can you confirm if there have been any reported links with an increase in miscarriage and the COVID-19 vaccination?**

The Royal Jubilee Maternity Service are not aware of any such link. In fact, the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists have stated there is no evidence of any such link.
