Protocols in place for Abortions - Termination of Pregnancy

- 1. How many abortions have included the procedure whereby the life of the foetus is ended, using potassium chloride or some other chemical, before labour is induced?
 - 19
- 2. Is it the policy of the Trust to administer pain relief to the foetus before such procedures as outlined above, and including evacuation/Dilation and Extraction are performed?
 - Our policy is to administer Atracurium prior to the administration of lidocaine/potassium chloride. This acts as an intrauterine neuromuscular blockade. Dosage is dependent on fetal weight, and this is calculated prior to the procedure.
- 3. What is the protocol in the Trust if a foetus is delivered/induced/born alive following an attempted abortion/termination of pregnancy/induction?
 - The Trust is currently developing a protocol for the regional feticide service. This will be informed by legal guidance from DoH. The protocol is not finalised and not available at present.
