The number of patients who have received electroconvulsive therapy (ECT) under the Trust's care between January 1 2019 and February 5 2024

Between January 1 2019 and February 5 2024, there have been 88 patients who have received electroconvulsive therapy (ECT) under the Trust's care

The number of patients who had complications recorded following electroconvulsive therapy (ECT) under the Trust's care between January 1 2019 and February 5 2024

Between January 1 and February 5 2024, there was <5 patient who had complications recorded following electroconvulsive therapy (ECT). This was related to the anaesthetic, not ECT and treated accordingly.

We are unable to provide an exact figure where numbers are very low. To provide this level of information would reduce numbers to discoverable limits where the patients could be identifiable.

Disclosure would constitute a breach of the principles of the Data Protection Act 2018.
