On the 3rd June 2020 , it was announced on the BBC Nolan Show that the Department of Health expected the Clifton Nursing Home Serious Adverse Incident (SAI) report to be made public.

Health Minister Robin Swann told the BBC that he expects “ fullest possible transparency “ in relation to the report.

Why did the Belfast Trust choose not to release the report to the public?

SAI reports are learning documents containing patient and family-sensitive information which are not appropriate to share in full and they are not published.

The Belfast Trust released to the public a summary report for the Muckamore Abbey SAI. Will you do the same for the Clifton Nursing Home SAI ?
