1. Do you have a Tier 3 specialist weight management service for obesity, with multi-disciplinary input?

Belfast Trust does not have a Tier 3 specialist weight management service for obesity

- 2. How many patients have been referred to this service in the past year? None, Belfast Trust does not have a Tier 3 specialist weight management service for obesity
- 3. What medications are prescribed as part of this service? Specifically, are Orlistat (Xenical) and Saxenda (Liraglutide) prescribed? Or Wegovy (semaglutide) used for obesity management?

This is not applicable as there is no Tier 3 specialist weight management service.

- **4.** Do you have a Tier 4 weight management service (i.e. weight-loss surgery)? Belfast Trust does not have a Tier 4 specialist weight management service for obesity
- **5.** How many bariatric surgeries have been conducted in the past year? The Health & Social Care Board, now part of the Department of Health, has not commissioned a bariatric service in the Trust. The question needs referred to the Department of Health.
- **6.** Is there an obesity care pathway for referral and if yes, can this be shared? Nutrition and Dietetics accept referrals for Obesity: BMI  $\geq$  30 from all health care professionals including GPs. There is a regionally agreed care pathway for treatment of obesity for dietetic referrals and is attached.

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
