AHP (Dietetics, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Podiatry, Speech and Language Therapy):

As above, this information is not held centrally and to provide it would take more than 18 hours work.

By way of explanation regarding questions 1 & 2, Belfast Trust's Allied Health Professions are unable to break down their agency usage into number of hours worked, departments and professions as to do so would require the service to undertake a trawl through all invoices on the FPM system and undertake a manual count. For example, in physiotherapy alone this would involve around 300 invoices per month.

The Trust considers that the cost of retrieving the information to respond to question 1 and 2 for AHPs would be above the 'Appropriate Limit', as defined by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 under Section 12. Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act makes provision for public authorities to refuse requests for information where the cost of dealing with them would exceed the appropriate limit. The limit has been specified as £450 for public authorities such as Belfast Trust. This represents the cost of one or more persons spending 18 hours in determining whether we hold the information, locating, retrieving and extracting the information.
