TVT Procedures in 2012

- 1. How many TVT procedures were carried out on women in 2012 within the Trust?**

- 4. How many consultants were involved in carrying out these Colposuspension procedures on women in 2012 within the Trust?**

We are unable to answer your request as once the costs of your FOI requests which have been received within the last 60 days have been aggregated, the cost of this will exceed the 18 hour limit. Your FOI request has been refused in line with Section 12 (1), as the request would of compliance would exceed the appropriate limit set out in the Act and (4) (a) allows us to aggregate multiple requests which have been received within 60 days together.

As per the FOI Act: Section 12 (1) does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit.

Section 12 (4) The Minister for the Cabinet may by regulations provide that, in such circumstances as may be prescribed, where two or more requests for information are made to a public authority-

- (a) by one person, or
- (b) by different persons who appear to the public authority to be acting in concert or in pursuance of a campaign,

the estimated cost of complying with any of the requests is to be taken to be the estimated total cost of complying with all of them.
