Proposed permanent order to restrict the sale and supply of GnRH

I would like to make a freedom of information request regarding Belfast Health and Social Care's participation in the Commission on Human Medicines report on proposed permanent order to restrict the sale and supply of GnRH agonists in children and young people under 18 years of age for the purpose of puberty suppression in gender incongruence and/or gender dysphoria.

Belfast Health and Social Care Trust's adult services agreed with the proposal. Can you please share who in the trust made this decision? Can you share any materials/evidence that caused the trust to make this decision? Can you share any discussion with external organisations regarding this consultation?

The Belfast Trust Adult Gender Identity Service and Adult Endocrinology service for Transgender Patients did not respond or input into the "Commission on Human Medicines report on proposed permanent order to restrict the sale and supply of GnRH in children and young people under 18years of age for the purpose of puberty suppression in gender incongruence and/or gender dysphoria.

The Trust would recommend that this query is directed to the Commission on Human Medicines for clarity.
