Complaint against a medical practitioner on the grounds of conversion therapy

Under the FOI Act, please can you tell me whether the Trust has ever been made aware of a complaint against a medical practitioner, practice, or other body, on the grounds of 'conversion therapy' or 'conversion practice'?

I can confirm that the Trust has received <5 complaint relevant to the question asked. No concerns were identified by the Trust relating to clinical treatment and care provided.

We are unable to provide an exact figure where numbers are very low. To provide this level of information would reduce numbers to discoverable limits where individuals could be identifiable.

This is exempt from release under section 40(2) Personal Information relating to a third party, of the FOI Act. This information would be unfair to the individuals to release this information. Disclosure would constitute a breach of the principles of the Data Protection Act 2018.
