As a Trust with a diverse workforce, we are very conscious of the safety of our staff as they make their way to and from work each day and it is deeply worrying that some staff have been subjected to racist abuse. This is unacceptable behaviour and we would encourage any of your constituents working at Belfast Trust, subjected to racist abuse, to report each incident to the PSNI and to tell their line manager.

Belfast Trust has a **zero tolerance** approach to abusive behaviour. We are very proud of our diverse workforce and it is important that our employees reach out to their colleagues, look out for each other, and support those who have experienced any racist hate crime or abuse.

## Protests Planned for Today

We are aware of a number of protests planned in Belfast City Centre on Friday 9 August. The majority of our hospital services will continue as normal. However, there will be disruption to some community services.

Patients and service users who may be impacted by this disruption have been contacted directly and alternative arrangements put in place.

This is a fluid situation and while we will strive to deliver services as normal, we accept there may be an unforeseen circumstance that requires us to cancel, postpone, or reschedule an appointment or prevents us from delivering planned care in the community.
