

## Daily Covid19 Update to SLG – 4th December 2021


The Charles Vincent Daily Safety Huddle Sit-Rep contains a wide range of data and is available on the Senior Leadership Group Teams Folder.

A summary of six key pieces of information relating to hospital inpatients, numbers of patients in Intensive Care, numbers of care homes in outbreak, workforce pressures, vaccination programme and PPE daily stock levels is set out below;

### 1. Covid19 positive (+) and Post-Covid19 Hospital Inpatients

Today, 62 Covid19+/clinical Covid patients are in our hospital wards and there are 24 patients post-14 days, in hospital. In total, 86\* Covid19 related patients remain in hospital. Today's number in hospital equates to 32% of the total at the peak of Surge 3 on 20<sup>th</sup> January (272). The graph displays both current and post-Covid19 patients.


#### 2. Numbers of Patients in Intensive Care

In Surge 3, the number of Covid+ Inpatients in ICU peaked at 33 on 25th January.

Today in ICU, we have 9 Covid19+ patients, and 0 suspect Covid19+ patients. On the wards\* there are 8 patients on CPAP, 5 on AIRVO and 1 on NIV. There are less than 5 patients identified as possibly needing escalation within the next 24 hours.



## 3. Community


We have 89 care homes in the Belfast Trust area, caring for over 2,200 residents.

As at Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> December, we have 10 care homes with a confirmed outbreak – 6 in amber status and 4 in red status (1 less care home in red and 1 additional in amber since the previous report).



#### 4. Workforce

As at Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 487 staff are off work with Covid19 disease related issues or vaccine side effects, which is significant given that on top of these absences we have ongoing workforce challenges because of high vacancy levels within the Trust. The same day last week, we had 445 staff off work with Covid19 disease related issues or vaccine side effects. Today's figure shows a 15% increase on the same day last week.

#### 5. Vaccination programme

# The Trust vaccination programme commenced before Christmas 2020, over the Christmas period and throughout 2021.

The table below shows the vaccination activity for the most recent 7-day period, and the cumulative total so far. Nursing and Care home residents, wards and day care facilities and staff, Walk-in clinics, Covid19 Vaccination centre numbers and wasted dose numbers are provided. Figures for Covid-19 booster doses and Winter 2021/22 Flu vaccinations are also now included. The daily number of vaccinations carried out averaged over 1,130 in April, 860 in May, 830 in June, 570 in July, 640 in August, 377 in September, 950 in October and 750 in November. The total number of vaccinations is over **281,000**. Over 17,000 vaccinations have been carried out at the mobile unit.
