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School of Dentistry Supervised Student Clinic Attendance

This leaflet outlines what you can expect when you attend the Urgent Student Clinic and any supervised Dental Student Clinic.

Referral to Supervised Student clinics

Some patients are suitable for training dental students. You will be advised if you are suitable for one of these clinics. This does not replace ongoing dental care and treatment with your own dentist.

The Dental Team

All dental students are supervised by a qualified dentist to oversee your treatment. Dental Nurses will be in attendance.

Medication

The dentist may be required to check your medication history on Northern Ireland Electronic Care Record but it is useful to bring the details of any medications you take to the appointment



Please allow adequate time for car parking

What will happen at your appointment ?

- You will report to reception and be shown to a waiting area.
- Your treatment will be completed by a dental student under the supervision of a qualified dentist.
- If you do not wish to be treated by a student dentist you should inform reception.
- Often you will be required to have an X-Ray undertaken—this takes place during your visit.
- Treatment by a student does not replace the need for regular dental check-ups with your own dentist.

This visit may take approximately 1 hour to complete

What happens next?

Please ask any questions you may have with regard to your condition and the proposed treatment plan.

You will be discharged back to the care of your own dentist after completion of student treatment.
